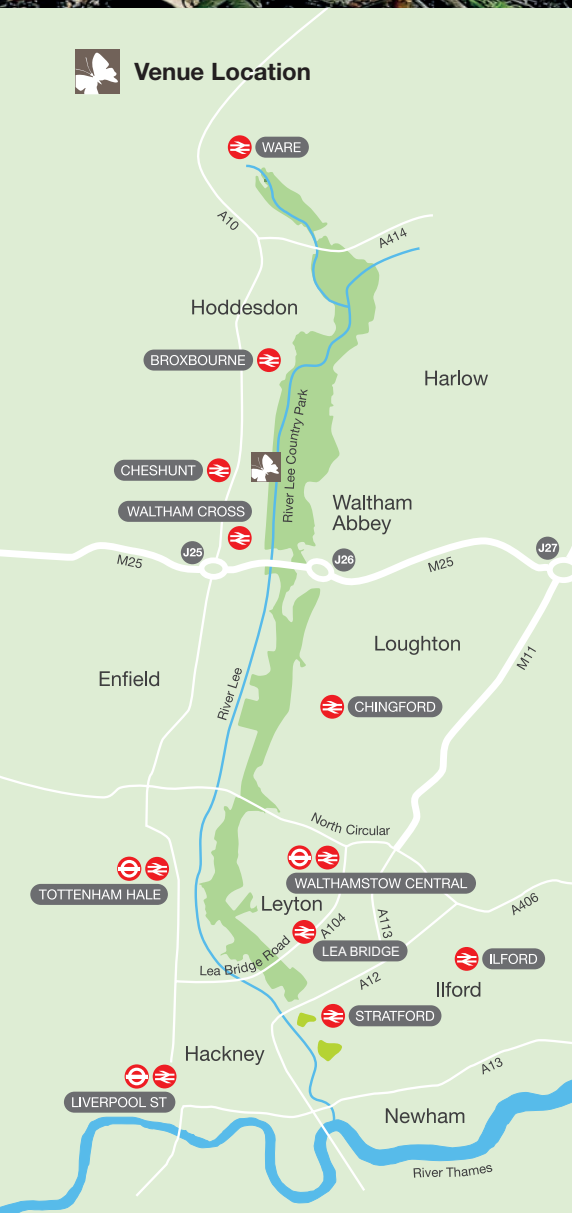




Venue Location



A gateway site into River Lee Country Park

This site is an important gateway from Cheshunt train station and YHA London Lee Valley with many visitors entering the park at this location. This is one of the busiest areas of the park with multi use, including a dog agility course, open grassland, trees, part of the sculpture trail and themed discovery trails.

It's an important part of the small River Lee and is a buffer to the urban and industrial corridor following the London to Cambridge railway line. North Met Pit, just a short walk south of the main gateways area, is also an important area for reedbeds and habitats for resident wildlife.
