A large site with a country park feel consisting of two large lagoons, wildflower meadows, woodlands and various habitats. Used in the past as an airfield, then gravel quarries and finally a landfill site. The deep open water of the Nazeing Meads lagoons offer plentiful food for diving ducks and in winter support a large roost of gulls.

Adoption of this site will support the work undertaken to manage and improve the biodiversity of the site.
