Tottenham Marshes has been used by Londoners for over 100 years but now nature has been given priority. This urban space has been adopted by many wildlife species and is a key site in an industrial landscape for nature. The grassland supports some excellent plant communities and orchids are found in summer.

The site has a thriving volunteer support network and excellent community links. It's important to many people in this area as a green open space and somewhere for wildlife to exist in the industrial landscape of the Lee Valley. Adopting this site would support the land management programme that's undertaken by the park and volunteer groups.
