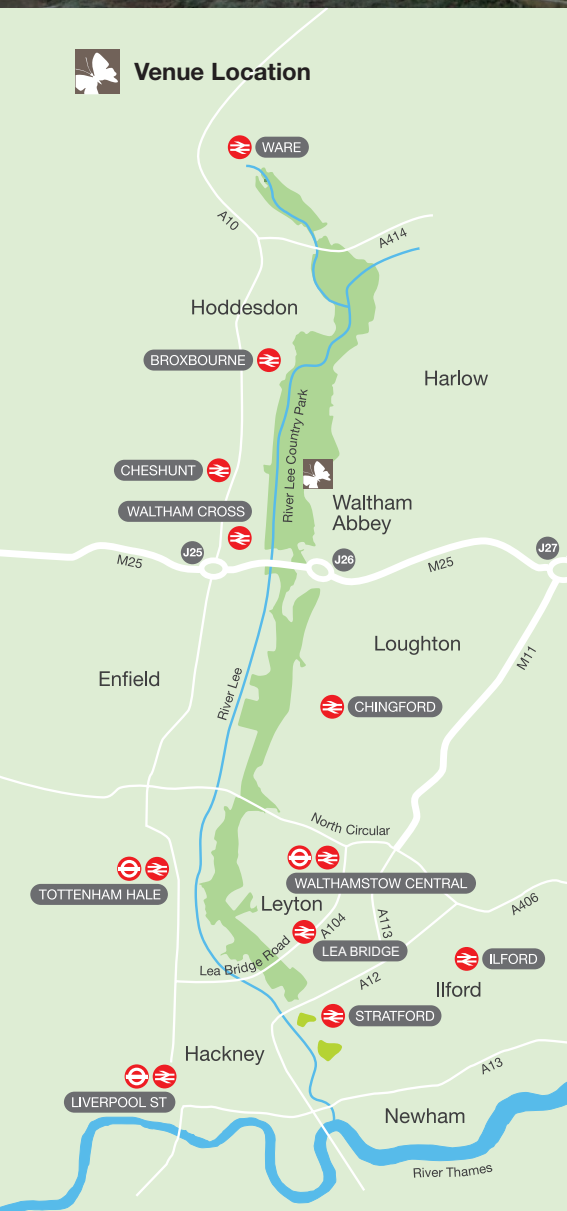




Venue Location



A haven for wildlife

This site boasts a diverse mix of habitats and flora and fauna and is a wildlife watchers haven. With large expanses of reedbeds across Seventy Acres Lake it's renowned for regular wintering Bittern, a scarce bird probably with no more than 100 birds wintering in the UK. This site, regularly holding between one and four birds each winter, is significant. The Wildlife Discovery Centre has fantastic views over the lake and reedbeds also gives the chance to see close-ups of the wildlife on our live camera streams from over the lake.

Adopting this site will support the management of the lake and surrounding areas to ensure that it continues to be the wildlife haven that it's renowned for.

Facilities

- Area where marquees can be erected
- Toilets
- Modern café nearby at Lee Valley Park Farms serving hot and cold food
- Car parking for up to 40 cars
- Transport links: main line train station 25 minute walk and easy access from junction 26 on M25

- Team building activities such as Scavenger Hunt, Human Knot, The Mine Field or the Egg Drop
