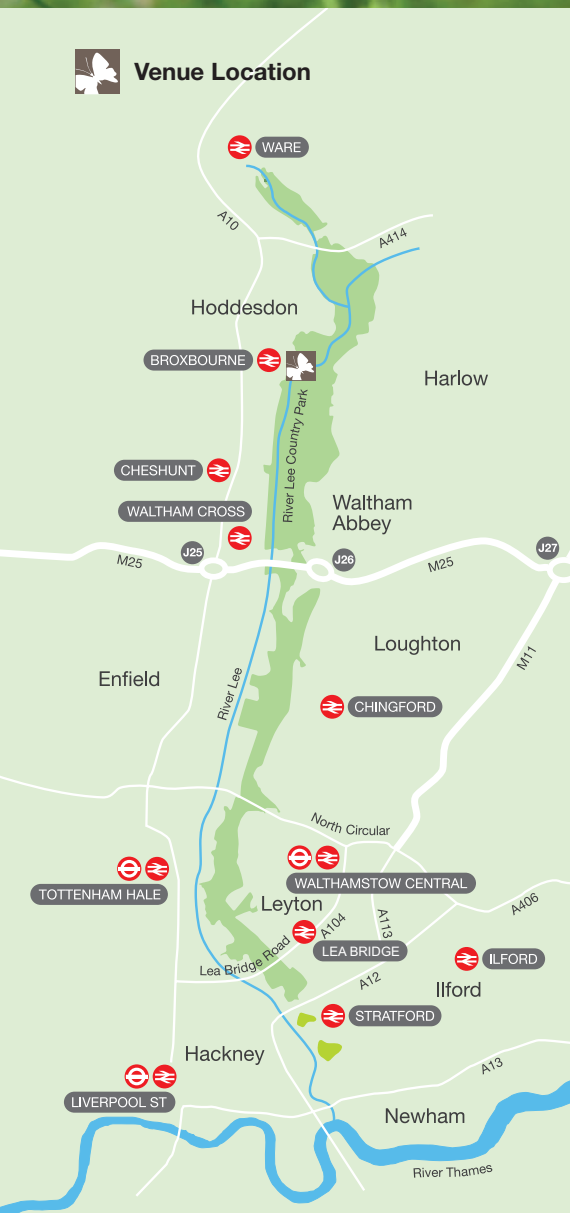




Venue Location



Unique site sandwiched between transport links

Silvermeade is a mosaic of wet meadows supporting a wide variety of plants and is one of the few remaining ancient flood meadows left in the Lee Valley.

The site supports a colony of Water Vole, a protected species under UK legislation, in its network of ditches. This important habitat requires constant management to ensure it's optimum for this iconic and much loved animal.

The support received from adoption of this site will be used to continue the management required to support Water Vole habitat.

Facilities

- Toilets and café serving hot and cold food nearby – five minute walk
- Car parking available nearby – five minute walk
- Transport links: main line train station 10 minute walk and easy access from A10
