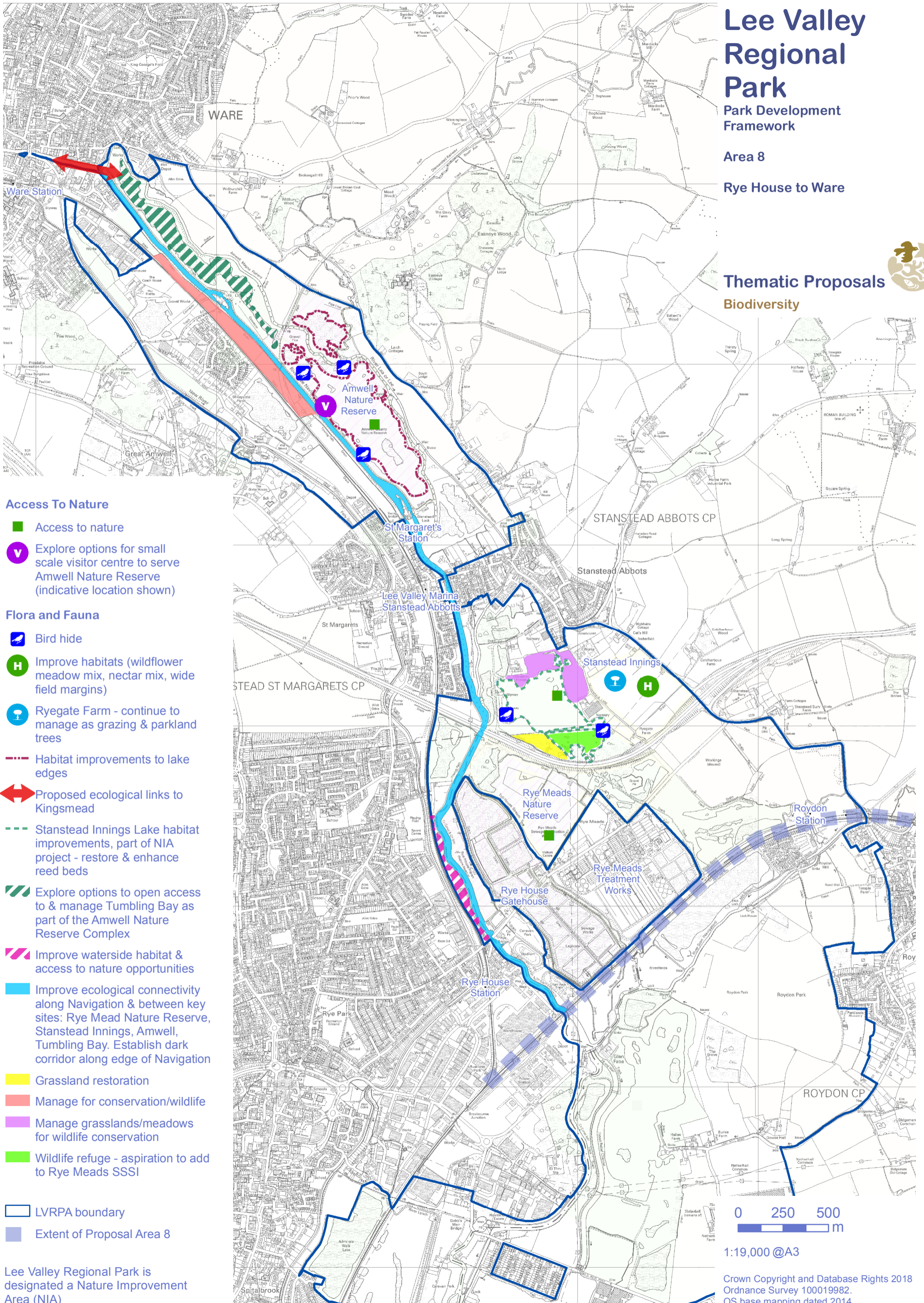

- H Improve habitats (wildflower meadow mix, nectar mix, wide field margins)
- Ryegate Farm - continue to manage as grazing & parkland trees
- Habitat improvements to lake edges
- ↔ Proposed ecological links to Kingsmead
- Stanstead Innings Lake habitat improvements, part of NIA project - restore & enhance reed beds
- /// Explore options to open access to & manage Tumbling Bay as part of the Amwell Nature Reserve Complex
- /// Improve waterside habitat & access to nature opportunities
- Improve ecological connectivity along Navigation & between key sites: Rye Mead Nature Reserve, Stanstead Innings, Amwell, Tumbling Bay. Establish dark corridor along edge of Navigation
- Grassland restoration
- Manage for conservation/wildlife
- Manage grasslands/meadows for wildlife conservation
- Wildlife refuge - aspiration to add to Rye Meads SSSI
